Yet another test runner?



- No bundle & on-demand
- Browser's Native ESM
- Custom plugins & hooks (async)



- Bundle-based
- Lack of native ESM support
- Lack of async resolving and transformation support
- Duplication of efforts



- Lack of integrations like Snapshot and Mocking

Vitest

- Vite's config, transformers, resolvers, and plugins.
- Use the same setup from your app
- ESM first, top level await
- Out-of-box TypeScript / JSX support
- Smart & instant watch mode, like HMR for tests!
- Jest compatible: Expect, Snapshot, Mocking, Spy, etc.
- Native code coverage via c8
- JSDOM and happy-dom for DOM and browser API mocking
- Components testing (Vue, React, Svelte, Lit, etc.)
