Why Inbox-Zero?

- Being responsive
- Keep maintenance work in control
- Don't accumulate work
- Know what to focus on
- Reading repetitively also cost time

Building communities / Healthy contributions / Community health file

Creating a default community health file

You can create default community health files, such as CONTRIBUTING and CODE_OF_CONDUCT. Default files will be used for any repository owned by the account that does not contain its own file of that type.

About default community health files

You can add default community health files to a public repository called `.github`, in the root of the repository or in the `docs` or `.github` folders.

GitHub will use and display default files for any repository owned by the account that does not have its own file of that type in any of the following places:

- the root of the repository
- the `.github` folder
- the `docs` folder

For example, anyone who creates an issue or pull request in a repository that does not have its own CONTRIBUTING file will see a link to the default CONTRIBUTING file. If a repository has any files in its own `.github/ISSUE_TEMPLATE` folder, including issue templates or a config.yml file, none of the contents of the default `.github/ISSUE_TEMPLATE` folder will be used.

Default files are not included in clones, packages, or downloads of individual repositories because they are stored only in the `.github` repository.

TURN OFF **Notifications**

and call it a day



Seek for Notifications

don't let them seek for you

- Turn off Email & App **Push** notifications
- Look for notifications **proactively**
 - Use GitHub Notifications Inbox
 - Or try volta.net **Volta**

What to Focus

filter out the noise, prioritize

- Dismiss issues/PRs that are **closed/merged**
(when not participant in; trust your team)
- Dismiss notifications of
 - Bots 
 - New commits pushed to PRs
 - GitHub Actions cancelled
 - etc.

Wishlist to GitHub

- GitHub Notifications API, **Please!**
- Fine-grained notifications filter
 - Bots, type of notifications, random ping, etc.
- More interactive notifications inbox
 - Live updates
 - Avoid hard refreshes

Warping up

- Keep maintenance scope manageable, don't let it grow out of control.
- **Reply and forget** - new notifications will come up once you get replies.
- Use tools to help you focus.
- **Enjoy it!**
